Environmental Health are in the process of reviewing the Ashdown Executive Summary Report, dated May 2025, and the Ashdown Remediation Strategy, also dated May 2025 submitted in support of the above application.

Section 4.2 of the Summary Report provides a summary of a ground investigations on the site with some detail on boreholes and ground conditions encountered. Whilst detail on this in the summary report is welcomed we would reasonably expect technical information of this nature to be presented in a comprehensive site investigation report with detail on the site investigation undertaken, borehole logs, chemical test certificates etc.

We can see that preliminary ground contamination assessments were submitted back in March and although these preliminary assessments are welcomed they are not site investigation reports as detailed above.
