MAIN COMMENTS: I appreciate the clear breakdown of the damage cost calculation. I have noticed what I believe to be a typo in the 2031 field for PM2.5 (should be 0.024085, not 0.24085) which has caused the overall cost to come out higher than expected. Other than this, the calculations align with mine. The cost of the mitigation measures exceeds the damage cost calculation, and it has been demonstrated that the measures go beyond what is required by other policies. Therefore, we accept the proposed mitigation measures.
