Comments:	<p>I object because this application contravenes the HDPF policies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">1 - it is not a strategic site in the local plan2 - it is not a nominated site in the Neighbourhood plan3 - It is outside the BUAB4 - the site is not noted in the Local Plan or Neighbourhood Plan it does not sit next to or join to an existing boundary

21 - as it not a strategic Gypsy and Traveller site
25 - as it does not protect conserve or enhance the landscape or townscape character of the area along with the setting of the South Downs National Park
27 - light and noise pollution in a dark skies area
33 - there would be a loss of amenity for the neighbouring property, the proposed development is not in keeping with its surroundings
40 - it does not improve the existing transport system and is not located in an area where there is a choice of local transport to the site.
Henfield has 9 new gypsy and traveller pitches: 2 in Shoreham Road , 5 in Furner's Lane and recently 3 pitches in Stonepit Lane. These pitches together are 10% of the 93 pitches in the plan and Henfield is only 3% of the Horsham district geographic area.
