Comments:	I am also concerned about the potential indirect impact of this development on existing community facilities in Barns Green, in particular The Queens Head Pub, which is a well-established and valued community hub. The scale of the proposed development would significantly change land use patterns in the area and may increase pressure for the loss or redevelopment of non-residential

uses in favour of further housing. The Queens Head plays an important social role for local residents, contributing to community cohesion and village life, and its loss would be harmful to the sustainability of the settlement. I consider it important that the council gives due weight to the protection of existing community facilities when assessing the wider impacts of this proposal.
