Comments:	I am concerned that the scale of this development could have wider consequences for existing community facilities in Barns Green, including the Queens Head pub on Chapel Road. uses, increasing the risk that valued facilities are lost over time. The potential impact on community life and village sustainability should therefore be considered as part of the planning assessment.
