ESTATE WHICH HAS A LARGE VOLUME OF ARTICULATED LORRIES LEAVING AND ENTERING 24 HOURS A DAY.

2. SMALL DOLE DOES NOT HAVE ANY GENERAL AMENITY APART FROM THE PUB AND A STORES. ALL OTHER AMENITIES ARE EITHER BY CAR TO HENFIELD OR UPPER BEEDING.

3. LAND DRAINAGE THE PROPOSED SITE IS SITUATED ON FLOOD PLAINS WHICH AT THE MOMENT CANNOT TAKE THE AMOUNT OF WATER THROUGH CLIMATE CHANGE AND FLOODS BOTH AT THE NORTH OF THE VILLAGE AND THE DRAINS CANNOT TAKE THE VOLUME FROM THE SOUTH OF THE VILLAGE FROM MACKLEYS INDUSTRIAL ESTATE.

4. HOW CAN 9 HOUSES PLUS ONCE THESE HAVE BEEN APPROVED ACCOMMODATE THE NEXT 20 OR SO IN THE ADJACENT GREEN FIELD BE IN KEEPING WITH THE CURRENT VILLAGE.
