Dear Jason,	
I am satisfied the revised proposal will preserve the interest of the historic building and ensure it is conserved for the future. Although the avenue of Blue Atlas Cedar trees forms a large part of the setting for Building 3, in heritage terms it is the position of the trees and their creation of a line of sight that is important. I would not object to their replacement with a more appropriate species that will provide the scale and grandeur of the existing trees.	
My only criticism is the design for the replacement gate house buildings. I would like to see a greater sense of arrival through increased architectural interest of these two buildings. I think they should be truly landmark buildings that make a statement as you enter the site. I am happy to discuss this with the architects.
