This is the second of three reasons I am submitting a comment on.</p> <p>Regardless of whether access to the site is to be via Furners Mead or the access point near the heritage trees on Furners Lane there is a narrow pinch point for vehicles driving east from the High Street up Furners Lane - approximately 10 yards west of the junction with Furners Mead. The lane at that point is no more than 10 or so feet across. Given that construction of 29 dwellings will involve considerable large scale bulky vehicular activity and the lane is used by many pedestrians, particularly dog walkers and</p>

parents taking their children for a walk in the country the
developers' proposals will inevitably give rise to a considerable
increase in risk of accident.
