Comments:	<p>I think there is too much development in Ashington. The school cannot cope with such an influx of families and we don't even have a Doctors surgery here, we have to go to Storrington and there is only one Surgery there.</p> <p>Rectory Lane is simply that, a Lane, and as such cannot cope with anymore traffic. There is excess traffic now with the development of Chanctonbury Nursery. With big lorries and large cars it is already difficult to pass. When electricity cables were put in for</p>

that site the Lane was closed for 5 and a half weeks!! This necessitated going the back way south to the A24 (a long round trip) to go north in a very narrow road with few passing places. This was very inconvenient and a road closure again is likely and would be definite with a new development. The Lane simply cannot cope with any more traffic using it.
