Comments:	<p>As someone who is awake much later in the night than most, I see and hear activity which would usually be unrecognised. Firstly, drivers which enjoy 'Drifting' have been known to use Knob Hill as it is an S-Bend. As of right now, there is no major safety concerns due to less activity at this time. However, with the new road connecting where it is proposed, there will be an increase in activity and this will become a major safety hazard for people leaving and coming home to the new estate.</p> <p>As of right now, the corner downhill of the S-bend also proposes a</p>

major safety concern. With drivers not slowing down to a proper speed, they often swerve to the wrong side of the road. I, along with many others, have had to fully stop when driving up-hill due to drivers taking the corner in an unsafe manner. With an increase in activity from the newly proposed road, this corner will become more dangerous and will inevitably cause an accident.

Motorcycle clubs regularly frequent Knob Hill on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays. With drivers already posing a risk to the motorcyclists, an increase in activity from the newly proposed road will only increase this risk.

Horse riders and cyclists alike are known to ride along Knob Hill. With the newly proposed road emerging where it is planned, drivers from the new estate may not see them and are likely to cause an accident.

Overall, the road is already dangerous. An increase in activity from another road will only increase this danger; not only for the current residents but also all the new residents from the planned estate.
