Comments:	Field adjacent to playing field forms part of the general amenity of the village and is part of what makes local circular walks within the village feel rural. Warnham is already overdeveloped when reviewed against its road infrastructure. It is understood that traffic and speeding through Warnham is affecting village life - especially on Bell Rd where the pavements are not adequately sized for the levels and speeds of traffic.

Warnham Parish Council have been implementing traffic calming measures over the past few years, which are currently failing as it is. New dwellings will exacerbate the issue as cars travelling from development to A24 South will go via Bell Rd.
