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

New Development at Warnham Village

We write to raise our objections to the proposed new development at Warnham for the following reasons:

- 1 Access from both ends of the new development is torturous and dangerous. This will be much worsened by the traffic created as a result of this development. Both Tilletts Lane and Knob Hill have restricted access due to parked vehicles and any additional traffic is most undesirable in both locations.
- 2 The new site is in an elevated position and will give rise to noise that will drift over the Village below.
- 3 The stormwater drainage system will be put under even greater pressure as a result of the increased runoff which will feed down into Church Street and Tilletts Lane.
- 4 The development will create a new boundary to the Village and will then provide the opportunity for even greater expansion in the future.
- 5 The development will impose a greater strain upon the facilities available in the Village and demand parking which is already fully utilized.
- 6 Yet more useful agricultural land will be taken out of service as a result of this development.
- 7 All 3 possible entrances and exit routes into the Village are hazardous. The additional traffic will increase this hazard.
