Comments:	First and foremost, this proposed development is not sustainable. Our village is in an area of limited amenities of which doctors and schools are already stretched. Existing residents realise that you need to own a car to quickly and safely access anywhere nearby.
	We have lived in Small Dole for over 20 years and have witnessed a dramatic increase in vehicle traffic over this period as the main

through road has become a rat-run throughout the day. A new development of 45 houses within the heart of the village will greatly add to this growing use of vehicles on our roads. There would be an increase to air and noise pollution from traffic but also light pollution from these dwellings.

It should not be forgotten that the use of this greenfield land will have an effect on our local ecology. Many species of birds, mammals and insects use the field, hedges and trees as habitat for feeding and breeding during day and night hours.

The access to the land from the main road would be of great concern due to the road's fast and sloped nature where southbound traffic comes off the brow of the hill, blind to the short stretch of downhill road. The village has a 30mph speed limit throughout, but this seems rarely adhered to with many greatly exceeding this figure.

We moved to Small Dole to escape increasingly busy and noisy town life to a more rural and quiet location and we feel along with many other residents that a development of this size will have an effect on our quality of life.

We are rapidly losing our village identities as planners try to incorporate more housing on sites that really do not deserve them for practical or sustainable reasons.
