Hi

It has been brought to my attention that Rusper Road will be used for construction traffic for this project. I assume that the road between the Hyde Drive roundabout and the prospective work site will be most heavily hit with this traffic.

As the new schools and shops are to be the first things built, might I take this opportunity to ask if one continuous pavement can be built from the building site to the Hyde Drive roundabout where children catch school buses etc. before the new build commences. Currently they cross the roads randomly.

Can I also suggest a zebra crossing can be added between the Summerhill estate to link them to this prospective new pavement? There are quite a lot of new families whose use the current path from Summerhill to Hyde Drive, this path is very narrow in places which makes pushing a buggy difficult, it is also quite damaged in places so difficult for wheelchair users, and of course, the current path is not fit for purpose as it is under water for a lot of the winter and the council apparently can't stop this from happening.

A new path, with a zebra crossing between both sides of Rusper Road, would be a solution to many problems for many.

Red lines along this stretch of road would also stop people parking on it, one person parking can interfere with a lot of traffic.
