I have been a regular customer at The Limeburners Pub for many years when it was up and running along with the busy caravan site the guy chip used to run both. There were many of the employees lived on the caravan site permanently. The caravan site was busy all year round as it's not just seasonal the land didn't flood as I used to bring my dog with me and walk across the field/caravan site even during the winter months. I can see by reading most of the comments people are concerned about traffic and parking I don't think these points

are relevant as this site has been used for a busy caravan park for over 30 years for 30 caravans which means 30 cars in total of 60 vehicles coming in and out onto a busy road which will now be reduced as there will be 24 residential units 24 vehicles and no mobile caravans coming in and out. My main concern is if this planning application is not approved then this is site will be extremely vulnerable to being used as a gypsy/traveller site. If 30 gypsy/traveller families wanted to pitch up there and stay for the period of 28 days then move off for 24 hours (probably camp somewhere illegally) then move back on the site and continue that cycle there is nothing stopping them they would be keeping to the original planning consent. There are many gypsy/travellers in the area and this could also attract others from out of area this could have a huge impact on the crime and anti social behaviour in the area it would also intimidate local people from using the limeburners pub due to the strong presence of the traveller community. This would be a terrible situation as the limeburners pub is a major part of the community. I feel that the 24 residential units would be a much more desirable option as the council would have more control on who are living on site i.e people on housing lists or elderly people ect. Of course the homes need to be that of quality chalet bungalows the same as people have on retirement parks. I would ask the council to please consider this matter as a serious concern. Thank you
