Comments:	<p>The access to the site from a busy main road would be of great concern due to it being dead opposite a very busy industrial site with large HGV vehicle movements in and out all the time. The village has a 30mph speed limit throughout, but this is rarely adhered to with many greatly exceeding this figure.</p> <p>Unsustainable Location - Small Dole is a hamlet, it has no</p>

schools, doctors (nearest being Henfield, 2.7 miles to surgery) dentists, police presence etc. There is no public transport to the Medical Centre or Sports Centre.

Flooding in the village is already issue after heavy rainfall, with further development this will only exacerbate the problem.
