Hi Steph,

Thank you for the extra information, I have now been able to log this development. I have added the details of the application and linked offsetting property to the SNOWS central registers.

Our records indicate that the offsetting property at the offsite dairy farm has sufficient offsetting capacity to meet the development's needs. The offsetting property is currently not linked to any other application.

Our records indicate that the total offsetting capacity currently available at the property was 15,000 litres per day, and this application's offsetting requirement is 5,040 litres per day.

Please note that our comments are based on the information that has been provided to us and available in the central SNOWS registers. This information may be out-of-date or incomplete, so we therefore recommend that you carry out your own checks on the suitability of any proposed offsetting.
