I have lived in Barns Green for nearly 30 years and on Chapel Road for 25 years

1/ Traffic: movement and parking is already an issue in Chapel Road, 68 more houses so potentially 120 plus more cars moving up and down it and probably parking along it. Parking for the Village shop is already limited.

2/ Flooding/sewage: Chapel Road floods easily already and the sewage plant cant cope with the existing homes now despite what Southern Water say. The entire road turns into a river.

3/ Over development: This small village has already taken over 100 new houses and now another 68 proposed on an unsuitable site causing excessive traffic, affecting road safety and severe destruction of historic hedging.

I strongly object to this proposal.
