Dear Ms Darley & Ms Parks,

I would like to strongly object to a detached bungalow being built within 1 meter of the front boundary of my house. I list the reasons below:

1. The outlook will be ruined (see attached pics) by a fence/wall and the building.
2. An alleyway will be created that will attract litter and unsocial behaviour plus a security risk to all houses
3. A 3 bed property could easily have 5 adults which means 5 extra cars in an already overcrowded car park area.
4. Opaque glass can be changed and a loft extension put in causing a further loss of privacy.
5. The grass area is currently well used by local children in a safe environment as can be seen by all houses.
6. There will be nothing to stop the bungalow removing fence panels and parking cars via the green/footpaths
7. This breaches part of article 8 under the mental health act including personal and mental/physical well-being.
8. This development has nothing to do with the housing quota and is a developer trying to make a fast buck to the detriment of the community here. This detached bungalow is completely out of keeping with all the semi-detached houses here.
