Comments:	This application, an application recently turned down on appeal, should be refused. The timing of the application appears to be, at best, opportunistic. As at 28th December 2025 no site application notice had been posted.

Muttons Lane is a single track rural road with access from Rock

Road on a sharp bend. At the other end, where it joins Newhouse Lane /Park Lane there is considerable winter flooding.

To our knowledge the aforementioned stables have never been used to house horses or any other livestock. The site has only been used to store building material and burn waste.

The rural location is wholly unsuitable for further development and close to a Grade 2 listed property.

There is a public footpath, regularly used, which runs across the site of the proposed development.
