Comments:	As a brand new resident to the area, moving in December 2025, we knew about building plans to the area, but were NEVER told that Carter Drive would become a through road for traffic. This proposed through road would drive right past our front door, in what is already a narrow stretch of road. Carter Drive is in no way a viable option for increased traffic, with extremely narrow corners, a large number of cars parked on the street, and a

distinct lack of pavements. Safety wise, it would be completely irresponsible to increase road traffic in an area where there are young families, and where pedestrians have no choice but to walk on the road - not to mention the awful increase in noise pollution and air pollution this would cause. The council has a duty to existing residents, and MUST OBJECT this new proposal. It is not safe, and NOBODY wants this as a new feature to what is a lovely neighbourhood. Carter Drive can not, and must not become the victim of these new plans, as many, many people have already made clear. We could not object any more strongly to this new proposal.
