Details of the pre-application advice received

It is possible to carry out various alterations and extensions to a dwellinghouse without the need for planning permission, through what are known as ‘permitted development’ rights. However, in this case these rights were removed as part of the original planning permission for your property (condition 22 of DC/15/0499). As a result of this planning permission would be required for the erection of an outbuilding within the rear garden.

At this stage there would be no apparent concerns were an application to be submitted, with the proposed outbuilding of a modest footprint. It would be recommended that the height / roof form be kept as low as is possible in order to prevent any potential impacts on the neighbouring garden area. The provision of a home office is similarly not of any concern, with working from home unlikely to create any significant potential for harmful levels of noise or disturbance.

It would therefore be recommended that a planning application be submitted to allow for public consultation and further consideration.
