Hi Matthew,

Further to the below and our previous discussions, please see our proposed offer of contributions below:

- A **£50,000** contribution to the local football club to support drainage improvements, ditch clearance and enhancement of the tree line along Broadbridge Way;
- A **£13,800** contribution towards Travel Plan vouchers (£150 per dwelling for 92 units);
- A **£43,000** off-site open space contribution, in accordance with the Parks Department's previous request; and

- A commitment to deliver off-site highway improvement works, to be secured through a Section 278 Agreement, without a financial cap, in line with standard practice.

As the development is not proposed to comprise 100% affordable housing, the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) will apply to the market dwellings.

These financial and infrastructure contributions represent a significant package of community benefits and should be afforded appropriate weight as a material consideration in the overall planning balance.
