Comments:	<p>The current main road through the Mulberry Fields development and access for future housing (Centenary Road) is highly unlikely to be able to withstand the increase traffic. Initially for construction vehicles and then increased volume of resident vehicles.</p> <p>The road had improvements at the start of 2025 due to issues with</p>

cracking and flooding and extra traffic will add to these issues. The road is also narrow with many vehicles parked on it (that should not be) and often makes the road unsafe due to restricted view of turnings. With many families and young children this could become unsafe. If the road is going to have an increase in traffic with more development then it will need to be managed with yellow lines and parking enforcement to allow full access. In the current state any construction vehicles will struggle for access due to the poor parking by current residents.

There should also be consideration for improved local amenities, with the increase of development in Southwater the local schools, doctors etc will struggle with the demand placed on them.
