

Proposed Stable Block

- 1 New courtyard timber structure with glazed roof covering and lead gutters
- 2 New slate roofing with 3 x new conservation roof lights and black painted metal guttering.
- 3 Existing telephone pole retained.
- 4 Existing containers relocated.
- 5 New retractable fabric awnings over terrace extension.

Proposed Potter's Cottage

- 6 Existing slate roofing over historic Stables building to be retained.
- 7 Existing slate roofing over historic Clocktower building to be retained.
- 8 Existing Clocktower to be retained.
- 9 New entrance lobby with new openings to new WC and storage cupboard in place of existing WC.
- 10 Existing kitchen stays as is and previous opening to WC is removed.
- 11 Under-stair storage as existing.
- 12 Large living room in place of previous bedroom.

Proposed Carriage Cottage

- 13 All bedrooms on second floor stay the same as their existing layouts.
- 14 New ensuite bathroom to Bedroom 1 in place of existing storage.
- 15 New bathroom layout.
- 16 New partitions to replace existing modern partitions and create new appropriate layout.
- 17 New entrance lobby leads onto;
- 18 Large bedroom;
- 19 Modern bathroom and;
- 20 Open plan living space.

Proposed Honey Cottage

- 21 New partitions to replace existing and create new appropriate modern layout. Historic doors reinstated.
- 22 New hallway leads onto;
- 23 Bedroom 1;
- 24 Bedroom 2 and;
- 25 A modern bathroom.
- 26 Slate roof with conservation rooflights to lightweight extension.
