I have encountered vehicles that have been parked on this blind bend and many vehicles where I have had to swerve and make an emergency stop at 17/20mph at that point. If the council are adding more vehicles into the area, on that dangerous low visibility bend, will make it worse, not too mention all the mud!! There are already 2 sites in close proximity for travellers, to this proposed site. So surely this is
