Comments:	I live local to the limeburners pub and campsite. I am part of the gypsy/traveller community. I am neutral to this planning application because I believe if the planning permission is granted it will fill a great affordable housing need within the area whilst also bringing the limeburners pub back to life I think this layout and the type of upmarket park homes that will be sited will look very nice not out of place in this nice area personally I think this would look alot better than 30 touring caravans .However if

planning permission wasn't granted this would be a positive on behalf of my community as there is a major shortage of gypsy/traveller pitches in the area with many people on the council site lists for over 10 years with no pitches coming available forcing people to camp illegally. This site would be a perfect location to house many gypsy/traveller families that simply don't have anywhere to go given them a safe stable stopping place with facilities such as electricity and running water. I have many friends and families that have enquired about the site and we have spoken to the new owner about when the site could be open. I know the site has been licensed for 30 caravans for many years for all year use for a period of 28days. This would not affect us as we would have somewhere safe to stay for the period of 28 days and then move off site for 24-48hours then move back on for another 28day period it would still be a much more stable situation as these families are used to moving every few days from place to place so this condition would not affect them. I would ask to be notified of the outcome and see this as a positive either way.
