Comments:	<p>I refer to the extensive planning history of this site. Particularly relevant is the appeal decision for Dc/16/1664. This is believed to be relevant to the current application. The access is difficult along the unmade track and the access from Hampers is narrow for construction vehicles and deliveries of materials.</p> <p>Additionally Hampers Lane is a public bridleway. The Inspector noted this in para 15 of the appeal decision and imposed a pre-commencement condition of submission of a</p>

Construction Management Plan.

Officers are requested to require such a plan and review any plan in the light of the lack of any public parking on Hampers and its dual use as a public bridleway. Also review the provision of bin space for the three/four properties on this track.

Consideration also needs to be made on the amenity impact for The Mandarin and Badgers Hill as well as other properties in the vicinity.
