As a resident in the same lane i wish to object to application.

Henfield already has Traveler's sites on Shoreham Road, Furners Lane and Stonepit Lane and together these 3 sites alone form 10% of the districts requirements.

It would be unreasonable and detrimental to the area for Henfield to take more than it's fair share as government advise is to have them in a broad area not all close together and this application would add a further 50 % to Henfields allocation bringing it up to 15 % of the Districts requirement when in fact Henfield is only 3% of the districts land area.

It has been used as a camp/ caravan site without permission being applied for over the last few years no doubt with the current application being the original intention. This type of tactic has been seen before and granting this application would only serve to encourage it to be used again in the future.

The site is agricultural and is in an unsuitable location for the intended use . It would cause harm to the character of the neighbourhood and its residents. It's not included in the Neighbourhood Plan and access is very pore. A narrow country lane,no public transport no pavements and practically no street lighting,extremely dangerous for pedestrians.
