Comments:	I am concerned about access because West End Lane is a narrow lane used by residents for walking their dogs. The coming and going of trailers could provide a health and safety problem. This site is a good 20 minutes walk from the High Street which will encourage car use.

The site would need extensive hard landscaping to accommodate the trailers. Currently it is an attractive grassy area which blends in with the rest of. I can't see the site integrating with the area.

There is already a nearby site in Stonepit Lane which also feeds off West End Lane. I feel that 2 pitches in such a small area is not fair to the country feel of that part of Henfield and this patch will be easily visible.

This was not allocated as a travellers' site in the neighbourhood plan.
