Comments:	The proposal to build a further 75 homes on this site is unsustainable within the facilities and amenities available within the village and immediately surrounds. There is already a acute shortage of GP medical, educational and other facilities locally. This site was not allocated for development in the detailed and approved community neighbourhood plan as such to allow this

over development will contravene and negate the development plan and have a major negative impact on the residential environment and character of the village.

Crucially, there is insufficient capacity to add any further load to the provision of fresh water and handling of sewage within the village and additional demands liable to lead to serious environmental issues.

The access to the site via Rectory lane is both narrow and restricted at all times of the day with severely limited parking and the additional traffic created both by the construction of this development and eventual residential use is unsustainable on this road.

Consent for this proposed development should be refused.
