Comments:	I object to the planning request for the site at Girder Bridge primarily due to concerns about access and flooding. Access to the site is problematic as it is located on a blind bend, increasing the risk of accidents if a 6-dwelling site is added. The narrow

access track is inadequate for larger vehicles, and regularly floods (it's a swamp in wet weather), meaning it will not be suitable for residents, neighbours or local services to access throughout the year. The road under the bridge often floods when we have a few days of heavy rain, and adding any kind of hardstanding to the track adjoining it will eliminate the natural flood defences that are in place, and cause more water to drain into the road. This is potentially very dangerous, as well as highly disruptive.
