Comments:	<p>I am writing to formally raise a serious complaint regarding the ongoing development adjacent to our property, which has caused significant disruption to our family's wellbeing, privacy, and daily life.</p> <p>This summer was meant to be a time of rest and recovery for our household. We spent months preparing our garden and pool to enjoy the holidays together. However, due to the proximity and intensity of the construction works, we were unable to use these spaces at all. The noise, dust, and lack of privacy have made it impossible to relax or carry out normal</p>

activities.

[REDACTED] had planned to begin rehabilitation in our pool. This was not possible due to the constant disturbance and environmental pollution, which has severely impacted my recovery. Additionally, the smoke and dust from burning fires have forced us to rewash clothes and keep windows closed, further affecting our quality of life [REDACTED]

The early morning noise from diggers, lorries, and skip collections has disrupted our sleep and daily routines. Our dog, once happy and playful, is now terrified of going outside due to the loud machinery and has developed a lasting fear of noise.

Unfortunately due to the noise and disruption of the work being carried out over the past few months [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] They require a quiet and stable environment to study and perform well, which will be entirely compromised by the ongoing construction.

We cannot endure further months-possibly years-of this disruption. We respectfully request that this planning of four dwellings does not get permission. We ask that you treat this matter with the seriousness it deserves. Our family's health, education, and emotional wellbeing are at stake.
