Comments:	I would like to thank 19 Bowes Close for the question they have raised on their comment and am answering this as others may have a similar concern  the current construction of the old building is from thin concrete panels with little or no acoustic and thermal value. The reconstruction of the new building will be using materials to comply with current regulations which, by their nature, have vastly

superior thermal and acoustic properties.  
The compressor mentioned is currently housed in a lean-to building with open ventilation.

Specifically, about the compressor, if there were to be a compressor in the new building, it would be located inside the main building, not in a lean-to out building as it is currently, with noise contained within the building.
