Comments:	<p>This development is not included in the Ashington village plan. Local amenities are stretched already - the impact on local schools and health services has not been considered.</p> <p>74 new houses is likely to come with over 150 new vehicles adding significantly to vehicle movements on Rectory Lane and Park Lane. These are rural roads used by walkers, cyclists and horse-riders. They are both single track roads without passing places. At peak times these routes are already under stress and</p>

the road surface is deteriorating badly under the weight of traffic. There is insufficient parking provision on the development plans for residents and visitors which will lead to Rectory Lane being used as additional parking which will further reduce the passing space for traffic.

Construction traffic during the buiding phase will add further degredation to the quality of life of those of us living on these lanes.

The design of the proposed houses is among the dullest and least imaginative I've ever seen . I object strongly.
